5- Respectez-vous la limite de personnes dans les rassemblements ou les véhicules ?

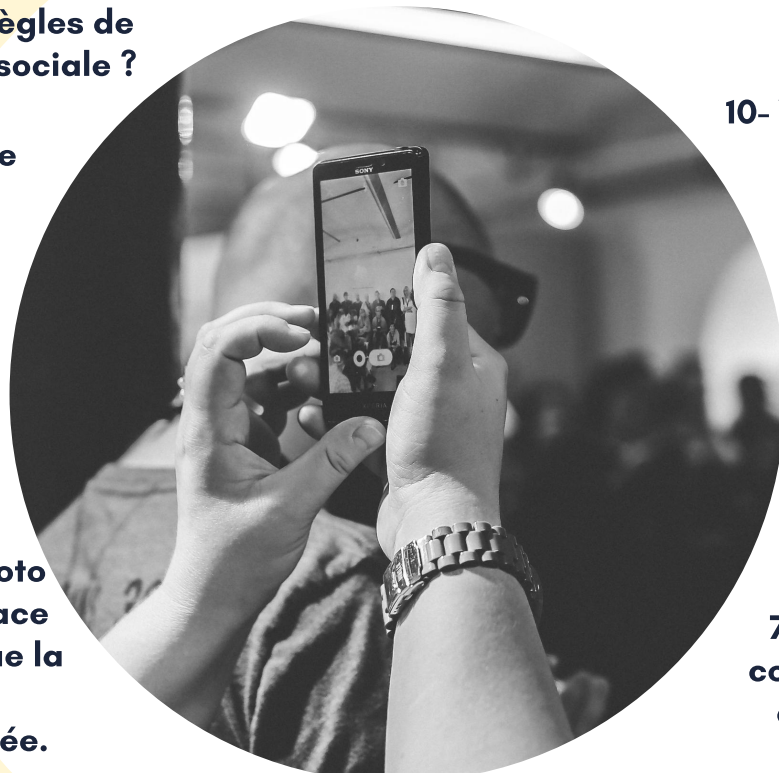
6- Si vous touchez plusieurs objets ou surfaces, portez-vous des gants ?
